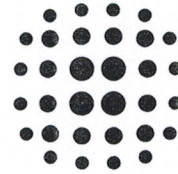

On receipt of your letter, I can confirm that I have arranged for an additional cheque for the sum of £200.00 to be sent to you.

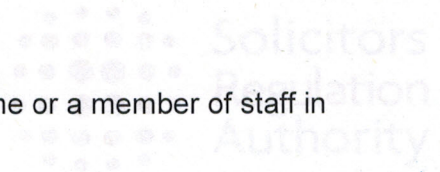
